Road Hazard Policy

This policy is valid for the life of the tire to (3/32") or six years whichever comes first and is extended to the original purchaser for as long as the vehicle is in your possession. Warranty covers all non-repairable failures such as punctures, tears, bulges or manufacturing defects incurred while driving on maintained roads, but excludes abuse, neglect, fire, collision, mechanical defects or vandalism.

This policy covers all replacement costs, including mounting and balancing, free flat repairs at our facility only and tire inspections. It does not cover towing or incidental damage to the vehicle caused by a blowout.

In the event of a tire failure please call us at 858 467-9999 or stop in Monday through Friday between 8:30 AM and 6:00 PM to proceed with the warranty. If the failure should happen outside of a 10 mile radius of our location, please call us for authorization. If outside of our business hours, please have your tire serviced at a tire dealer of your choice. You would need to bring us the original tire so we can verify the reason for tire failure. Any tire replacement performed at a repair facility other than Aero Auto Repair, will be paid for by us with

a credit card over the phone to the facility performing the work. When this is not possible you will be reimbursed by a credit to your account at our shop for the full price of the service, providing a receipt is submitted to us.

The tire will be replaced with a matching new one or where a matching tire is no longer available we will replace it with one of comparable quality and tread design at no charge for the first 50% of wear and prorated from that point to 3/32". Prorating charge will be waived for customers who have Aero Auto Repair perform all of their car's scheduled maintenance.

The cost of the "Road Hazard Policy" is \$9.95 per tire, or 10% of sold price of tire, (Whichever is higher).

Tires must be balanced at least every two years and rotated every 7,500 miles or at intervals deemed necessary for your vehicle by Aero Auto Repair, to qualify for the road hazard warranty. Proper wheel alignment must also be maintained and must be checked at least once a year.

This policy is secondary to any vehicle insurance policy and if tires are covered by insurance we will pay a maximum of the insurance deductible.

On most four-wheel or all-wheel drive vehicles, tires must be the same amount of wear or drivetrain damage may result. In the event of a tire failure on such vehicles Aero Auto Repair will install a new tire only if safe to do so. It will be the vehicle owner's responsibility to purchase the remaining matching tires to avoid damage.

This warranty is available for all vehicles, excluding heavy duty, fleet or off road usage.
